### -----OUR HISTORY-----

*John Alexander, an English sea captain and merchant, purchased 500 acres of land that became the present-day Alexandria, Virginia for "six-thousand pounds of tobacco and cask" in 1746. The city took his name and Alexandria was incorporated in 1749, and soon became one of the busiest seaports in the colonies.*

*Beginning around 1780 the Potomac River at the bottom of King Street was filled with earth and stone to reach the deep-water channel, to eventually become Union Street, and then The Strand. In just a few years warehouses grew on that new land. Sea captain John Harper built a four-story warehouse on the corner of Prince and Union Streets, formally the Christmas Attic, and sold much of the land on the north side of Prince Street to other sea captains for their homes, giving rise to the name "Captains Row."*

*In the late 1780's another building was added by Harper, it is now the Regatta Room and Whiskey Bar on the first floor of Union Street, and the George Washington Room on the second. This building was used for the commercial dealings of the merchants of the port city. George Washington reportedly met with Alexandria City officials in that office to discuss business issues concerning the city.*

*The main part of the restaurant, the Grill Room and Tap Room, were originally warehouses, but were twice destroyed by fire. The Grill and Tap Rooms were rebuilt in the early 1970's and used as King's Landing Restaurant. King's Landing was purchased by the current owners in 1985, totally rebuilt, and opened as Union Street Public House in November of 1986.*
